

Roll up your sleeves and plant native trees and wildflowers with us on Saturday April 25. Sustainable Stillwater MN is hosting a tree-planting event at Pine Point Regional Park in Stillwater. Trees are nature's carbon sinks and the world needs a billion of them planted this year to help remove carbon from the atmosphere. The folks at Washington County will give us as many native saplings as we have signups. Please RSVP at the link above - we will need a headcount. Plus if the event is cancelled due to the COVID-19, you will be notified by email.

Did you know you can inexpensive trees for your own yard? Every November, the Washington Conservation District has a tree sale at <a href="http://www.mnwcd.org/tree-sales">http://www.mnwcd.org/tree-sales</a> and it runs until they sell out (often by early to mid-March), with pick-up happening every year at the end of April at the County Fairgrounds. Bundles of 25 trees sell for \$35 and they have a wide variety of conifers, hardwoods, and shrubs, with lots of great options for providing wildlife habitat. Mark your calendars to check their website in November.

Stillwater is asking for public input on the Aiple Property on the St. Croix River just north of the Zephyr Theater. The City has come up with a plan for developing the park out of the Aiple residence. Take a look at how this gorgeous location is envisioned as a city park, and add your input on what they are planning.

What's your idea of best use? One of our members suggests it should be a park that includes accessible dock access to the river for quiet watercraft like kayaks, canoes, and paddleboards. There should indoor and outdoor space for environmental education for community youth and adults. This park will probably be very popular given its proximity to the bike trail, so plenty of bike parking might also be an addition. It's right off the heavily traveled Highway 95, so safe and well-marked crosswalks from parking areas on the west side of 95 would also be useful. Please take a minute and do the survey.
